

Configure EduBrite for Single Sign-On


Configuring EduBrite for single sign-on (SSO) enables administrators to manage users of Citrix ADC. Users can securely log on to EduBrite by using the enterprise credentials.

Prerequisite

Browser Requirements: Internet Explorer 11 and above

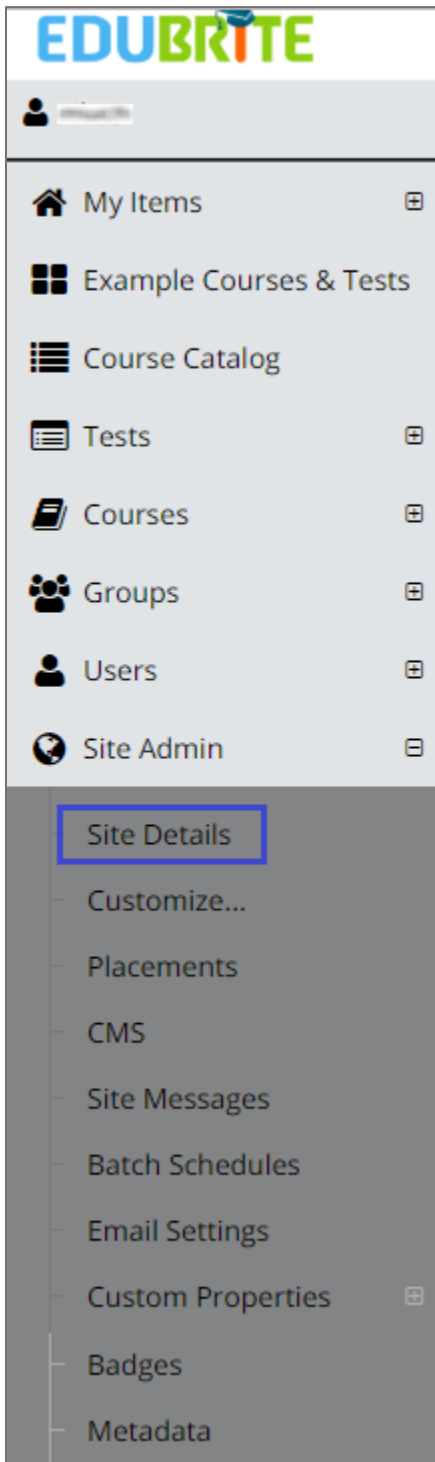
To configure EduBrite for SSO by using SAML:

1. In a browser, type <https://<customer domain>.edubrite.com/oltpublish/site/signin.do> and press **Enter**.
2. Type your EduBrite admin account credentials (**Username** and **Password**) and click **Sign In**.

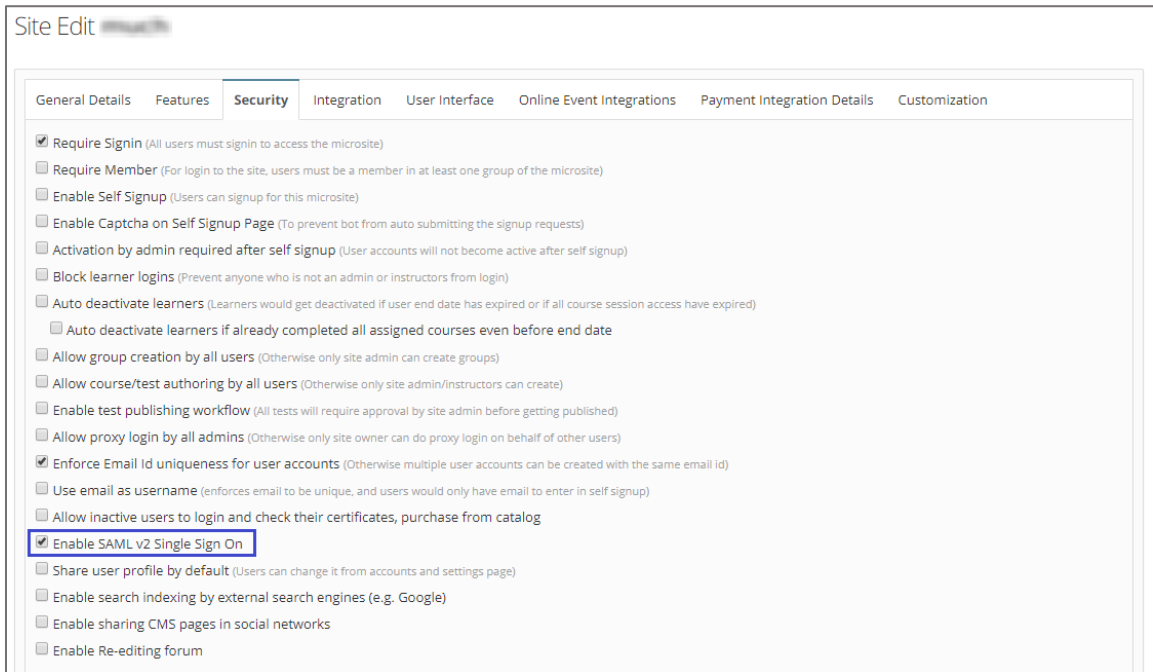

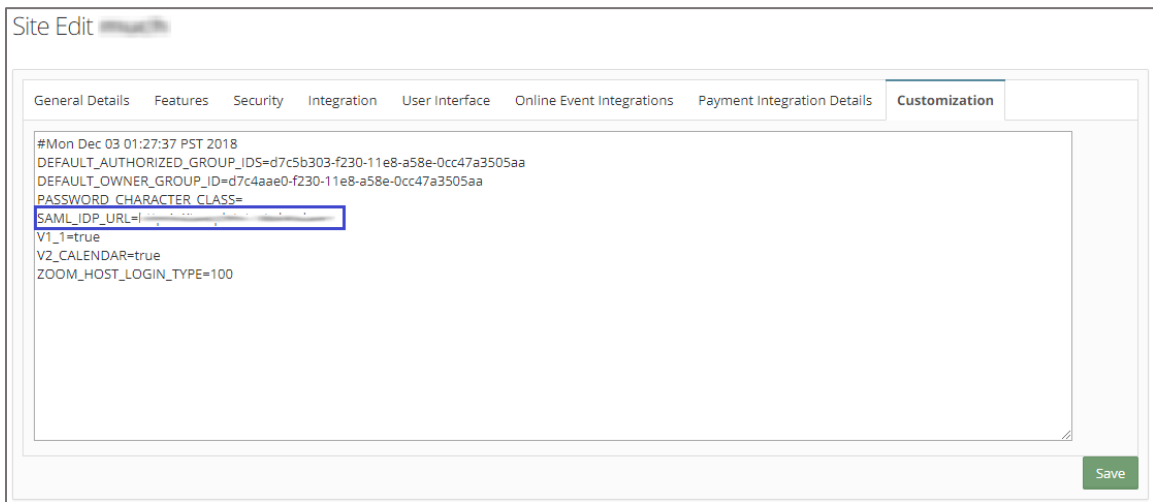
3. In the left panel, click **Site Admin** and select **Site Details**.



4. In the **Site Edit** page, click the **Security** tab and select the **Enable SAML v2 Single Sign On** check box.

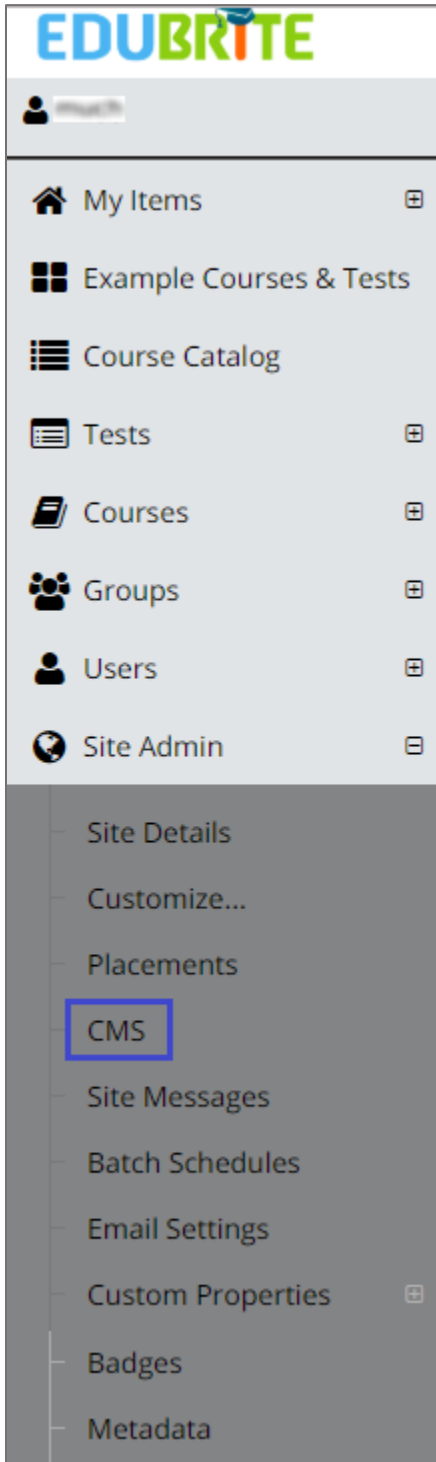


5. In the **Site Edit** page, click the **Customization** tab and enter the following value:
SAML_IDP_URL=<IdP logon URL>

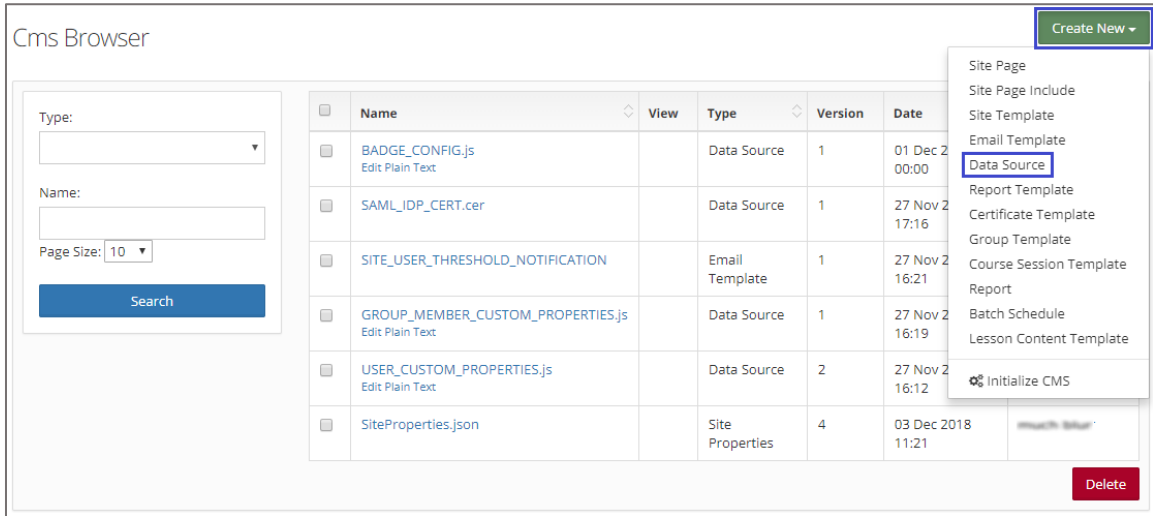


6. Click **Save**.

7. In the left panel, click **CMS** under **Site Admin**.

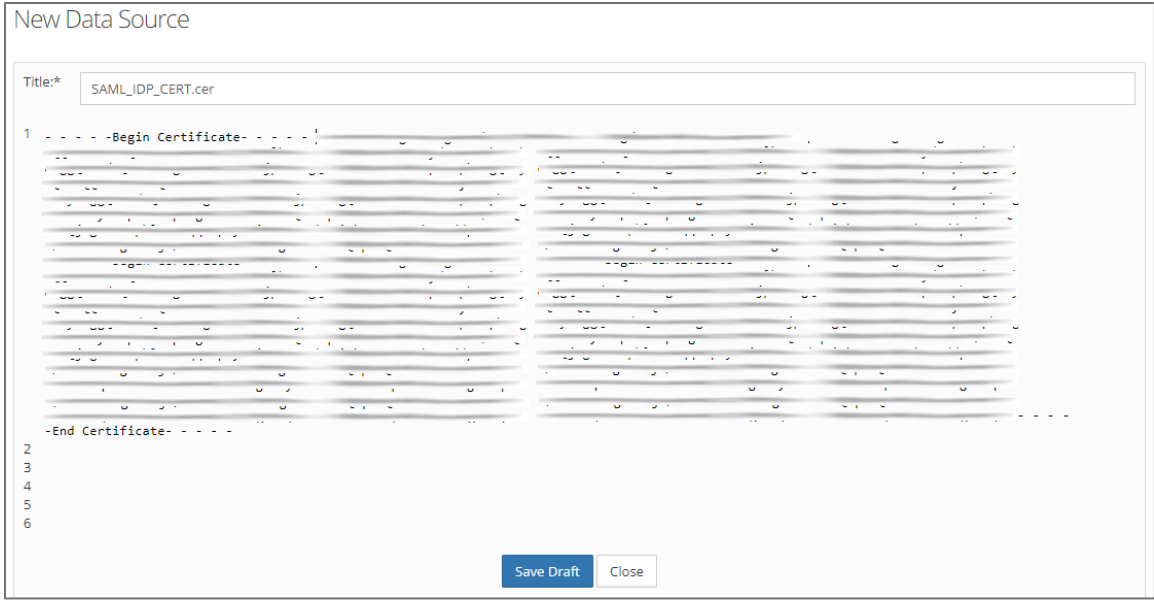


8. In the **Cms Browser** page, click **Create New** and select **Data Source** from the drop-down menu.



9. In the **New Data Source** page, enter the values for the following fields:

Title	SAML_IDP_CERT.cer

10. Click **Save Draft**.
