

# Configuring Pipedrive


Configuring Pipedrive for single sign-on (SSO) enables administrators to manage users of Citrix ADC. Users can securely log on to Pipedrive by using the enterprise credentials.

## Prerequisite

Browser Requirements: Internet Explorer 11 and above

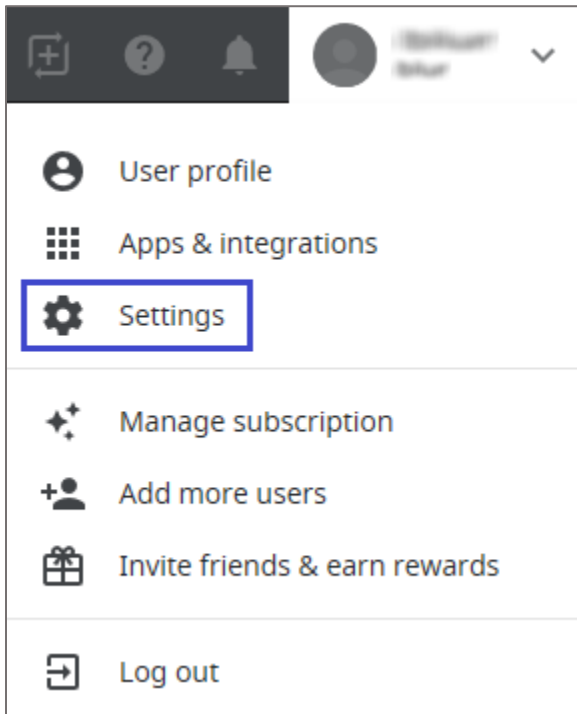
## To configure Pipedrive for SSO by using SAML:

1. In a browser, type <https://www.pipedrive.com> and press **Enter**.
2. Type your Pipedrive admin credentials (**Email** and **Password**) and click **Log in**.

Issuer	IdP issuer (Citrix)
Single Sign On (SSO) URL	IdP logon URL
Single Log Out (SLO) URL	IdP logout URL

## SSO/SAML

### SAML configuration for Pipedrive

Issuer

The issuer URL of the IdP. This is usually the same as the IdP metadata url.

Single Sign On (SSO) url

The url of your Identity Provider login endpoint.

Single Log Out (SLO) url

X.509 certificate

6. Scroll down and enable the **Enable for users** option.

The url of Pipedrive SSO login endpoint.

SAML attributes mapping

  "picture": "Avatar" // optional
};
```

The mapping needed on IDP side.

Enable for users  Enforce SSO login
