

Configure Roadmunk for Single Sign-On


Configuring Roadmunk for single sign-on (SSO) enables administrators to manage users of Citrix ADC. Users can securely log on to Roadmunk by using the enterprise credentials.

Prerequisite

Browser Requirements: Internet Explorer 11 and above

To configure Roadmunk for SSO by using SAML:

1. In a browser, type <https://app.roadmunk.com/login/> and press **Enter**.
2. Type your Roadmunk admin account credentials (**Email** and **Password**) and click **Log In**.

3. To enable and configure SSO, the user must contact Roadmunk support team and provide them with the following:
