

# Configuring Flatter Files

Configuring Flatter Files for single sign-on (SSO) enables administrators to manage users of Citrix ADC. Users can securely log on to Flatter Files by using the enterprise credentials.

## Prerequisite

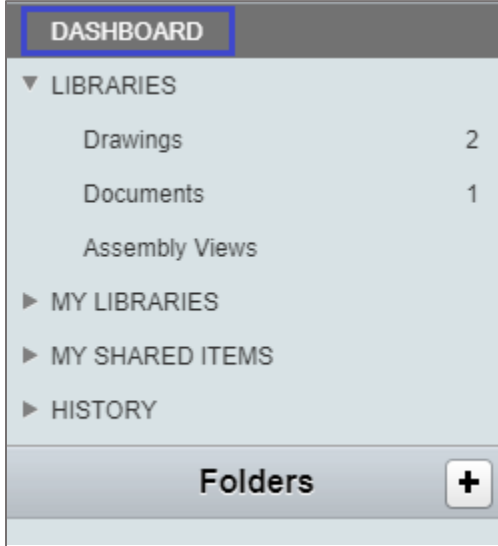
Browser Requirements: Internet Explorer 11 and above

## To configure Flatter Files for SSO by using SAML:

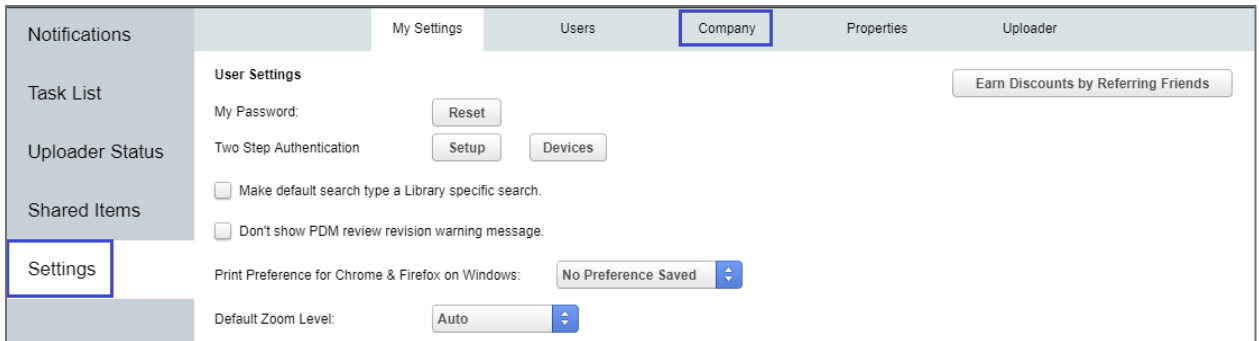
1. In a browser, type <https://www.flatterfiles.com/> and press **Enter**.
2. Type your Flatter Files admin account credentials (**Email** and **Password**) and click **Login**.

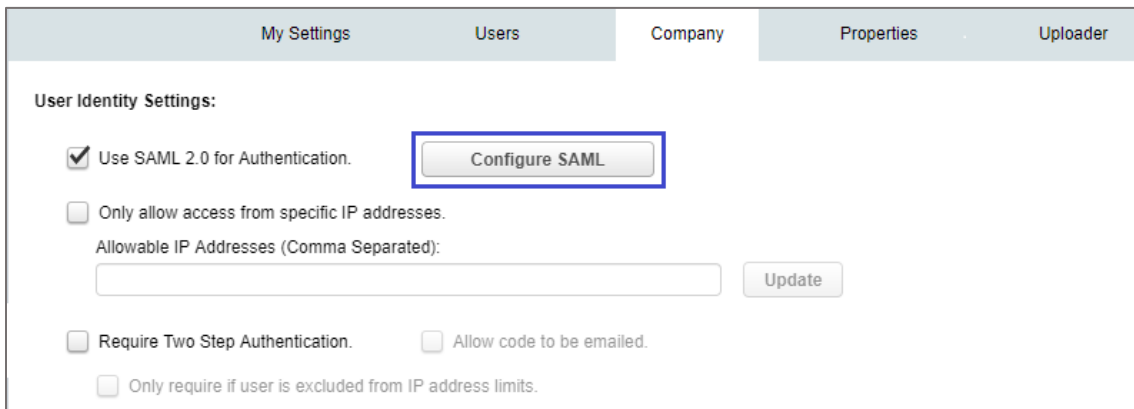
3. In the left panel, click **DASHBOARD**.



4. In the dashboard page, click **Settings > Company**.



5. In the **Company** page, select the **Use SAML 2.0 for Authentication** check box and click **Configure SAML**.



6. In the **SAML configuration** pop up window, enter the values for the following fields:

Field Name	Description
Domain (e.g. flatterfiles.com)	Domain name <b>Note:</b> Send the domain name to the Flatter Files customer support to add it to their database.
Identity Provider URL	IdP logon URL
Identity Provider Certificate	Copy and paste the IdP certificate. The IdP Certificate is provided by Citrix and can be accessed from the link below: <a href="https://ssb4.mgmt.netscalergatewaydev.net/idp/saml/templatetest/idp_metadata.xml">https://ssb4.mgmt.netscalergatewaydev.net/idp/saml/templatetest/idp_metadata.xml</a>
