


Configure OpenEye for Single Sign-On

Configuring OpenEye for single sign-on (SSO) enables administrators to manage users of Citrix Gateway service. Users can securely log on to OpenEye by using the enterprise credentials.


To configure OpenEye for SSO by using SAML:

1. In a browser, type <https://ows.openeye.net/login> and press **Enter**.
2. Enter your OpenEye admin email address and click **NEXT**.



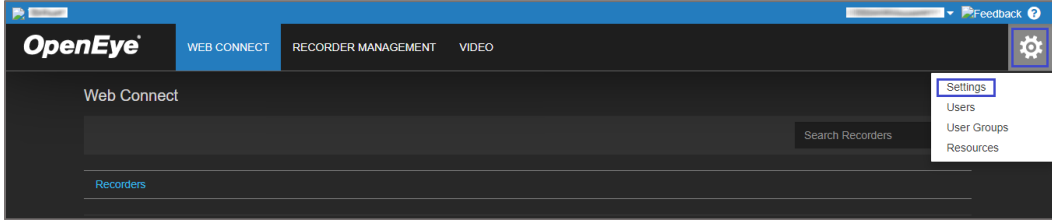

3. Enter your OpenEye admin password and click **LOG IN**.



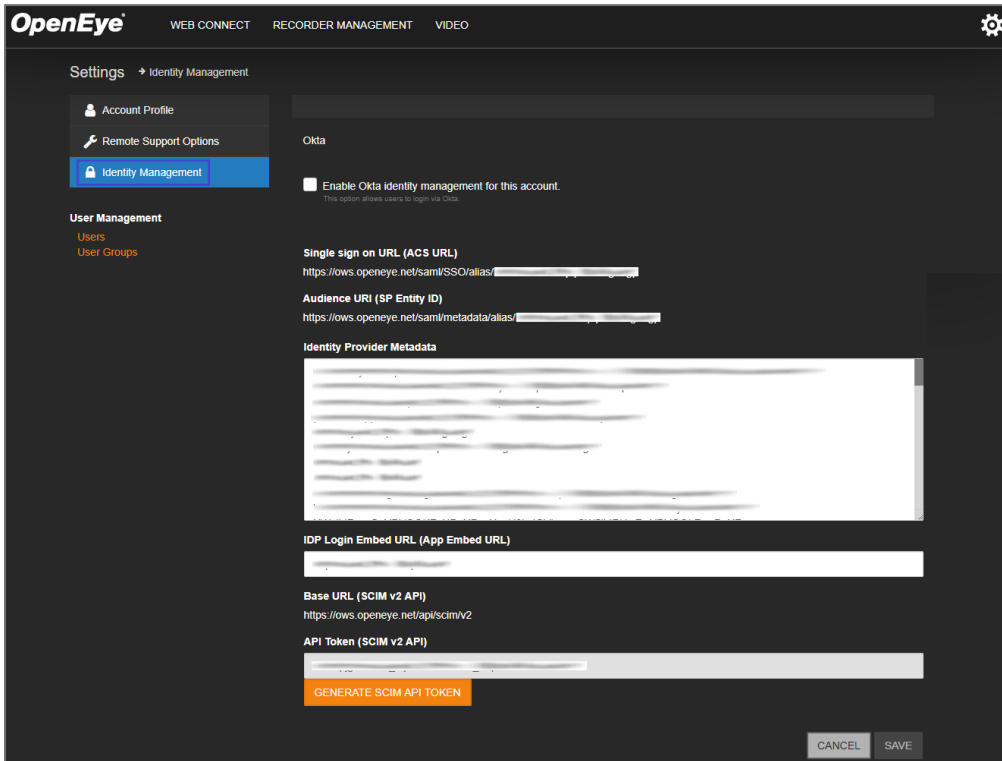

- In the dashboard page, click the settings icon in the top-right corner and click **Settings**.



- In the **Settings** page, click **Identity Management** and enter the values for the following fields:

Required Information	Description
Identity Provider Metadata	Copy and paste the IdP metadata. Note: Note down the **Single sign on URL (ACS URL)** and **Audience URI (SP Entity ID)** for IdP configuration.
