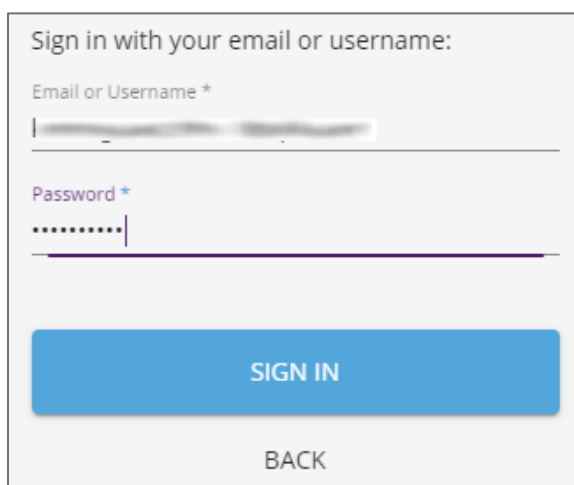


# Configure Pulumi for Single Sign-On

Configuring Pulumi for single sign-on (SSO) enables administrators to manage users of Citrix Gateway service. Users can securely log on to Pulumi by using the enterprise credentials.

## To configure Pulumi for SSO by using SAML:

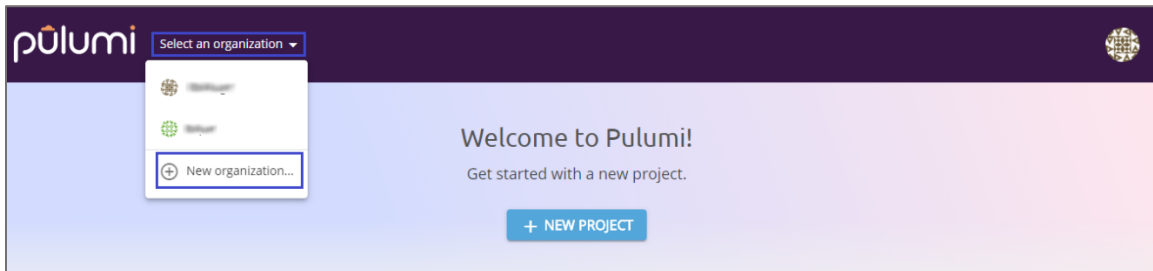
1. In a browser, type <https://app.pulumi.com/signin> and press **Enter**.
2. Enter your Pulumi admin account credentials (**Email or Username** and **Password**) and click **SIGN IN**.



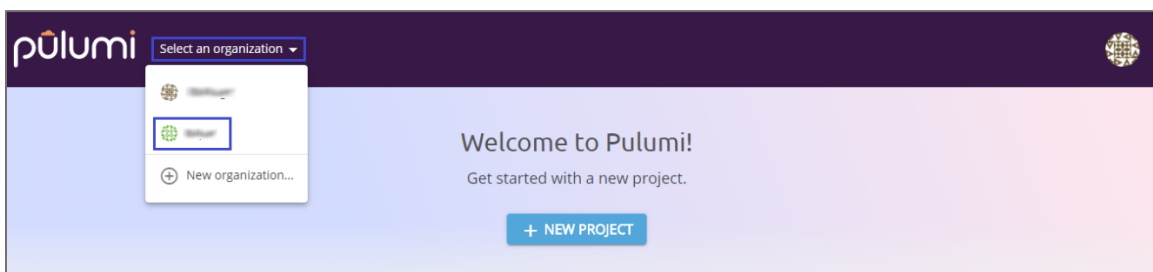

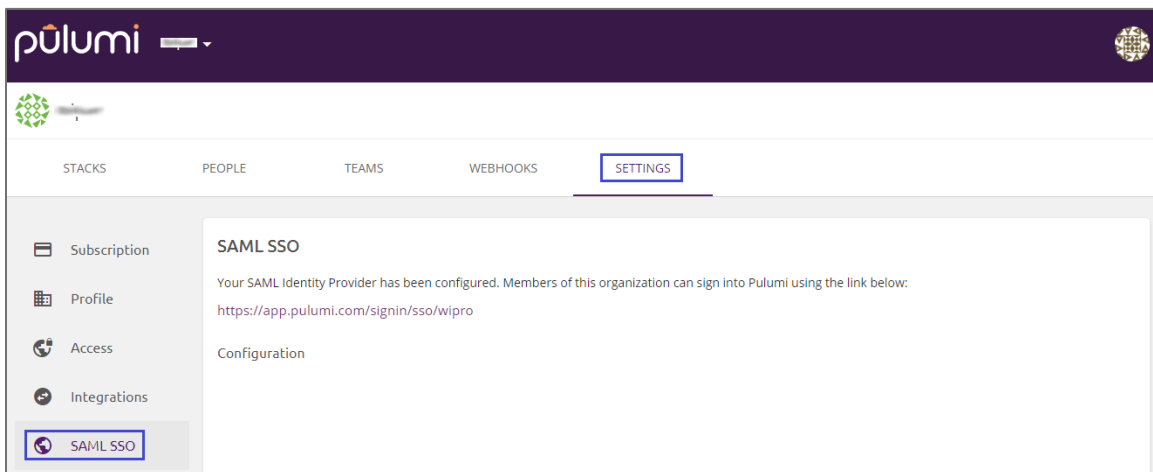
3. In the dashboard page, click **Select an organization > New organization** and enter your organization details.
