


Configuring Supermood

Configuring Supermood for SSO enables administrators to manage their users using Citrix Gateway. Users can securely log on to Supermood using their enterprise credentials.

Prerequisite: You need to contact the Supermood support team to enable your SSO account.

To configure Supermood for SSO through SAML, follow the steps below:


1. In a browser, type the URL, <https://preprod.supermood.co/app> and press **Enter**.
2. Type your email address and click **Next**.

3. On the Dashboard page, click **My account** in the bottom left corner. From the list, click **Single Sign On (SSO)**.
4. On the Single Sign On page, click **Add an SAML 2.0 configuration for an email domain**.



5. In the **Add an SAML 2.0 configuration for an email domain** section, type the following information:

- i. **Email domain for this identity provider:** Enter your email domain.
