


# Configure Workable for Single Sign-On

Configuring Workable for single sign-on (SSO) enables administrators to manage users of Citrix Gateway service. Users can securely log on to Workable by using the enterprise credentials.

## To configure Workable for SSO by using SAML:

1. In a browser, type <https://id.workable.com/oidc/i/> and press **Enter**.
2. Enter your Workable admin account credentials (**Work email** and **Password**) and click **Sign in**.

3. To enable and configure SSO, the user must contact the Workable support team and provide them with the following details:
