

Configuring Accompa

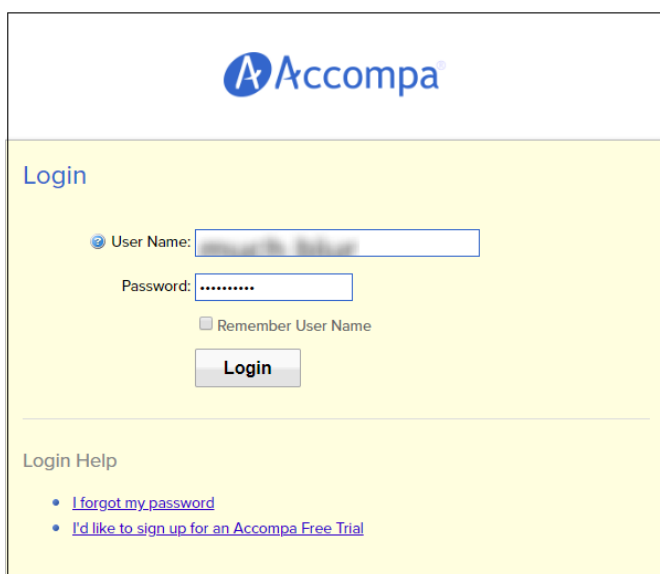
Configuring Accompa for single sign-on (SSO) enables administrators to manage users of Citrix ADC. Users can securely log on Accompa by using the enterprise credentials.

Prerequisite

Browser Requirements: Internet Explorer 11 and above

To configure Accompa for SSO by using SAML:

1. In a browser, type <https://www.accompa.com/> and press **Enter**.
2. On the home page, click **Login**.
3. Type your Accompa admin credentials (**User Name** and **Password**) and click **Login**.

4. To create SSO, click **Settings** that is present at the top-right corner of the screen, and select **Configure SAML SSO**.



5. In the **Configure SAML SSO (Single Sign-On)** page, enter the values in the following fields:

Field	Description
Accompa SSO Login URL and Entity ID	Make note of the Accompa SSO Login URL and Entity ID as it is required for IDP configuration.
SAML SSO Status	Select Active from the drop-down list.
Restrict to SSO Only	Select Users can login using SSO or Accompa login page radio button.
Issuer	Issuer URL
Identity Provider Certificate	Browse, copy and paste the IdP certificate. The IdP certificate must begin and end with -----Begin Certificate----- and -----End Certificate----- Note: The IdP certificate is provided by Citrix and can be accessed from the link below: https://ssb4.mgmt.netscalergatewaydev.net/idp/saml/template/test/idp_metadata.xml
Request Signature Method	Select RSA-SHA256 from the drop-down list.
Identity Provider Login URL	IdP Logon URL
Identity Provider Logout URL	Landing page URL (optional)
Custom Error URL	Error URL (optional)

Request Signature Method: RSA-SHA256	Select the hashing algorithm for encrypted requests, either RSA-SHA1 or RSA-SHA256
<input checked="" type="checkbox"/> Identity Provider Login URL: <input type="text"/>	The URL where Accompa sends a SAML request to start the login sequence.
Identity Provider Logout URL: <input type="text"/>	The URL to direct the user to when they click the Logout link in Accompa.
Custom Error URL: <input type="text"/>	Specify the URL of the page that the users are directed to if there's an error during SAML login. It must be a publicly accessible page.
