

Configuring KnowledgeOwl


Configuring KnowledgeOwl for single sign-on (SSO) enables administrators to manage users using Citrix ADC. Users can securely log on to KnowledgeOwl by using the enterprise credentials.

Prerequisite

Browser Requirements: Internet Explorer 11 and above

To configure KnowledgeOwl for SSO by using SAML:


1. In a browser, type <https://www.knowledgeowl.com/home> and press **Enter**.
2. Type your KnowledgeOwl admin account credentials (**Email** and **Password**) and click **Login**.



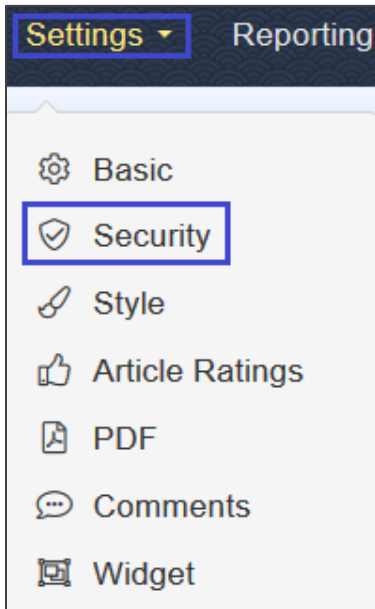

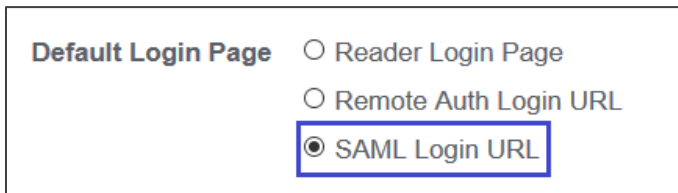

3. On the profile page, click **Security** in the navigation bar and select **Settings** from the drop-down menu.



4. In the **Security Settings** section, select **SAML Login URL** check box.



5. Navigate to the **SAML SSO Integration** section by scrolling down and enter the values for the following fields.

SP Entity ID	SP Entity ID
SP Login URL	SP Login URL
SP Logout URL	SP logout URL
IdP entityID	IdP entity ID
IdP Login URL	IdP logon URL
IdP Logout URL	IdP logout URL
KnowledgeOwl SP Metadata	Copy and paste the SP metadata. Note: The SP metadata is provided by Citrix and can be accessed from the link below: https://ssb4.mgmt.netscalergatewaydev.net/idp/saml/templatetest/idp_metadata.xml
Upload IdP Certificate	Upload the IdP certificate. The IdP certificate must begin and end with -----Begin Certificate----- and -----End Certificate----- Note: The IdP Certificate is provided by Citrix and can be accessed from the link below: https://ssb4.mgmt.netscalergatewaydev.net/idp/saml/templatetest/idp_metadata.xml

Note: The **Enable SAML SSO** check box is selected by default.

SAML SSO Integration

ⓘ Restrict Access to SSO will trump Public Default Access, requiring everyone to authenticate using SSO. Choose Restrict by Reader Logins as the Default Access to allow optional manual reader logins in addition to SSO.
