


Configure Contentful for Single Sign-On

Configuring Contentful for single sign-on (SSO) enables administrators to manage users of Citrix Gateway service. Users can securely log on to Contentful by using the enterprise credentials.

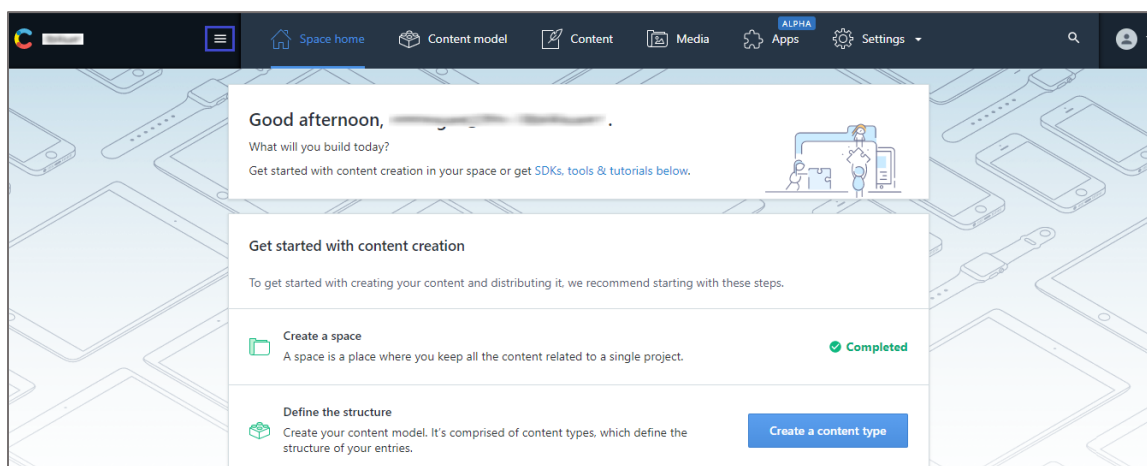
To configure Contentful for SSO by using SAML:

1. In a browser, type <https://be.contentful.com/login> and press **Enter**.
2. Enter your Contentful admin account credentials (**Email** and **Password**) and click **Log in**.

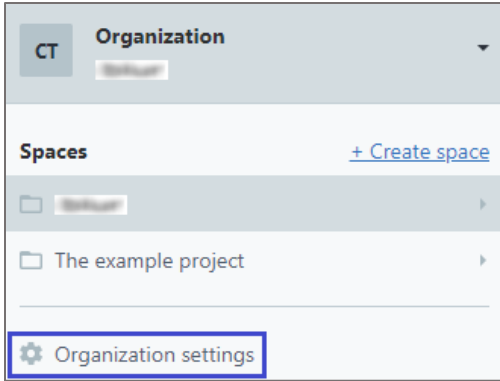

3. In the dashboard page, click the menu icon in the top-left pane.



4. Click **Organization settings**.



5. In the **Organization settings** page, click the **SSO** tab and enter the values for the following fields:

Required Information	Description
SSO Service URL	IdP logon URL
Signing certificate	Copy and paste the IdP certificate.
