

# Configure Copper for Single Sign-On


Configuring Copper for single sign-on (SSO) enables administrators to manage users of Citrix ADC. Users can securely log on to Copper by using the enterprise credentials.

## Prerequisite

Browser Requirements: Internet Explorer 11 and above


## To configure Copper for SSO by using SAML:

1. In a browser, type [https://app.prosperworks.com/users/sign\\_in](https://app.prosperworks.com/users/sign_in) and press **Enter**.
2. Type your Copper email address and click **NEXT**.

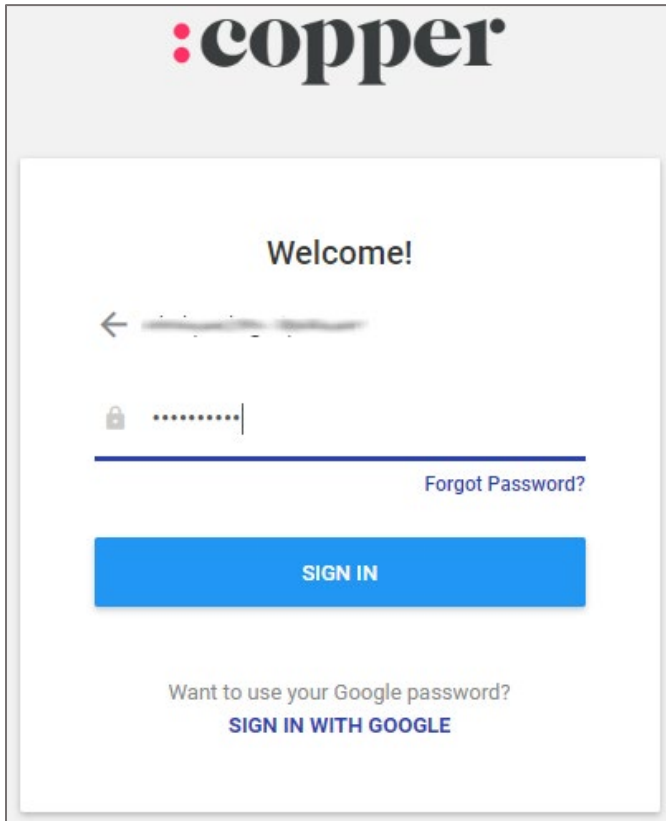

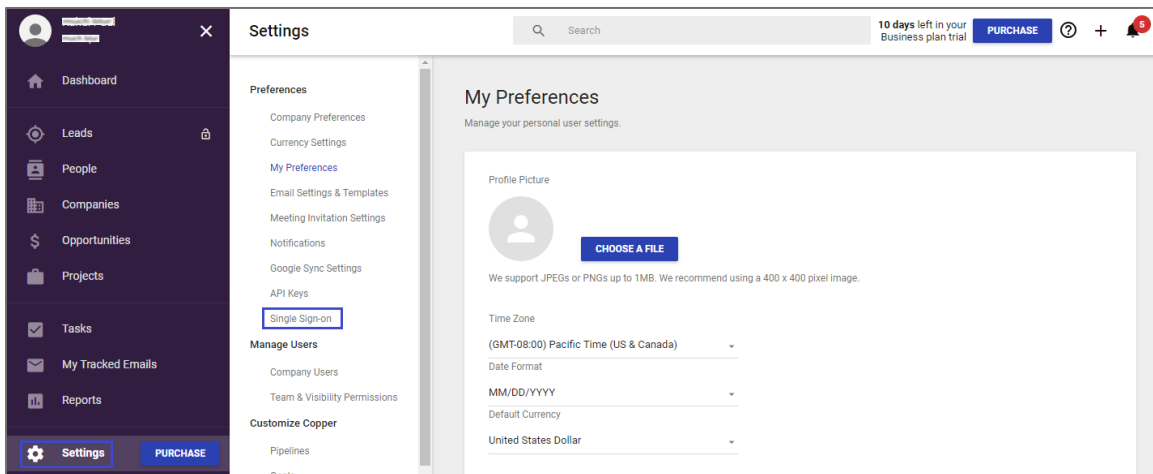

4. In the dashboard page, click **Settings > Single Sign-on** from the left pane.



- In the **Single Sign-on** page, turn on the **Enable Single Sign-on** toggle button and enter the values for the following fields:

Required Information	Description
Name	NetScaler
IDP SSO Target URL	IdP logon URL
IDP Issuer	Issuer URL
IDP Certificate	Copy and paste the IdP certificate. The IdP certificate must begin and end with -----Begin Certificate----- and -----End Certificate----- <b>Note:</b> The IdP metadata is provided by Citrix and can be accessed from the link below.
