

# Configure Easy Projects for Single Sign-On

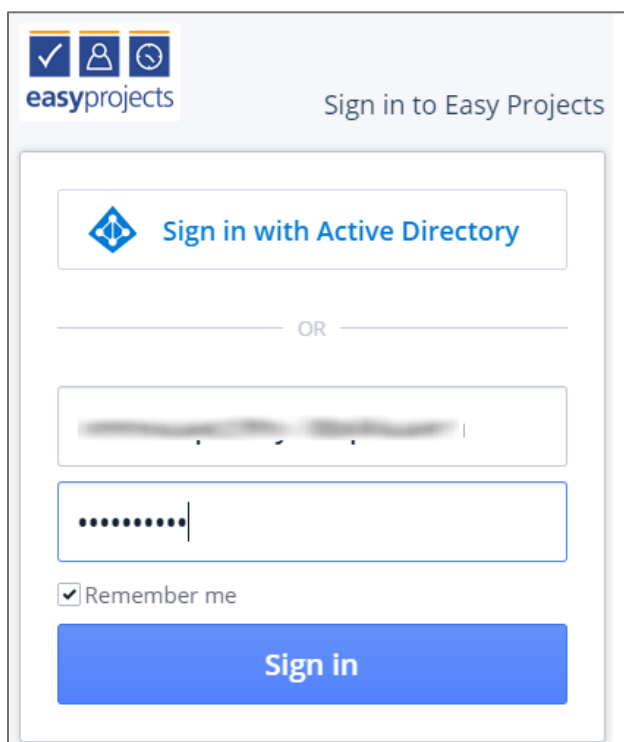
Configuring Easy Projects for single sign-on (SSO) enables administrators to manage users of Citrix ADC. Users can securely log on to Easy Projects by using the enterprise credentials.

## Prerequisite

Browser Requirements: Internet Explorer 11 and above

## To configure Easy Projects for SSO by using SAML:

1. In a browser, type [https://<customer\\_domain>.go.easyprojects.net/Login](https://<customer_domain>.go.easyprojects.net/Login) and press **Enter**.
2. Type your Easy Projects admin account credentials (**E-mail** and **Password**) and click **Sign in**.
