

Configuring GlassFrog

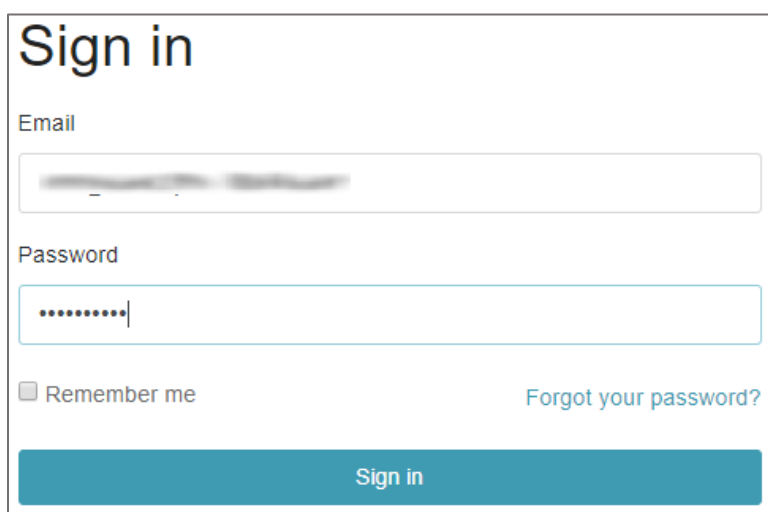
Configuring GlassFrog for single sign-on (SSO) enables administrators to manage users of Citrix ADC. Users can securely log on to GlassFrog by using the enterprise credentials.

Prerequisite

Browser Requirements: Internet Explorer 11 and above

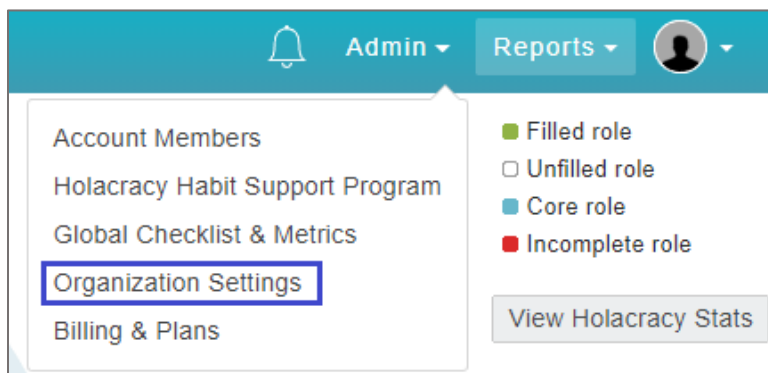
To configure GlassFrog for SSO by using SAML:

1. In a browser, type <https://www.glassfrog.com/> and press **Enter**.
2. Type your GlassFrog admin account credentials (**Email** and **Password**) and click **Sign in**.

3. In the top-right corner, click **Admin** and select **Organization Settings** from the drop-down list.

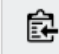

GlassFrog Account Creation

Manually create GlassFrog accounts
Only members with existing GlassFrog accounts will be able to login via single sign-on. You'll need to manually create an account for each member.

Automatically create GlassFrog accounts
GlassFrog will automatically create a GlassFrog account for any new member with valid credentials from your identity provider when they first log in. Be sure to give new users your Custom Single Sign-on URL so that they can access GlassFrog.

Additional Settings

Only allow login via SSO
Normal members will be forced to login via single sign-on, but admins will still be able to login normally.
