


Configure JupiterOne for Single Sign-On

Configuring JupiterOne for single sign-on (SSO) enables administrators to manage users of Citrix Gateway service. Users can securely log on to JupiterOne by using the enterprise credentials.

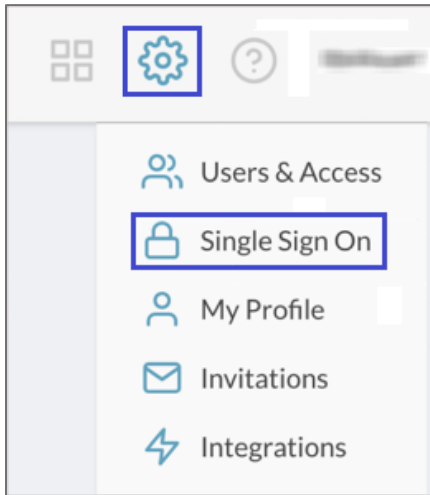
To configure JupiterOne for SSO by using SAML:

1. In a browser, type <https://<customer domain>.apps.us.jupiterone.io/home> and press **Enter**.
2. Enter your JupiterOne admin account credentials (**Username** and **Password**) and click **SIGN IN**.

3. In the dashboard page, click the settings icon and click **Single Sign On**.



4. In the **Single Sign On** page, click **CONFIGURE**.



5. In the **Configuration** page, enter the values for the following fields:

Required Information	Description
Client name	NetScaler
SAML Metadata Document URL	IdP logon URL

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SSO URL

This is the single sign-on URL that you need to enter in your IdP SSO application configuration Also use the above for Recipient URL and Destination URL

Audience URI (SP Entity ID)

This is the single sign-on audience URI that you need to enter in your IdP SSO application configuration

Client name

SAML Metadata Document URL

Allowed OAuth Flows

- Authorization code grant
- Implicit Grant
- Client credentials

Note: Copy the **SSO URL** and **Audience URI (SP Entity ID)** for IdP configuration.

6. Click the save icon.
