Configure Signavio for Single Sign-On

Configuring Signavio for single sign-on (SSO) enables administrators to manage users of Citrix ADC. Users can securely log on to Signavio by using the enterprise credentials.

Prerequisite

Browser Requirements: Internet Explorer 11 and above

To configure Signavio for SSO by using SAML:

- 1. In a browser, type <u>https://app-au.signavio.com/p/login</u> and press **Enter**.
- 2. Type your Signavio admin account credentials (**Email address** and **Password**) and click **Login**.



3. In the top-right corner, click **Setup** and select **Manage Collaboration Hub authentication** from the drop-down list.



4. In the pop-up window, enter the values for the following fields:
