## **Configuring SmarterU for Single Sign-On**

Configuring SmarterU for SSO enables administrators to manage their users using Citrix Gateway service. Users can securely log on to SmarterU using their enterprise credentials.

To configure SmarterU for SSO through SAML, follow the steps below:

1. In a browser, type the URL, http://<companyname>.smarteru.com/remote-login/login.cfm and press **Enter**.

- i. Enable External Authorization: Select to enable authorization.
- ii. Master Login: Select Both.
- iii. User Default Login: Select Both.
- iv. **Login URL:** Enter the IdP URL, SAML 2.0 endpoint, for example, https://example.com/saml/login
- v. **Customize Login Button Text:** Enter the text for Login button. This is used to log in with SSO.
- vi. **Customize Portal Login Button Text:** Enter the text for Portal Login button. This is used to log in to the default application.
- vii. **Enable SAML:** Select to enable SAML 2.0.
- viii. **IDP Metadata:** Enter the IDP metadata.
- ix. Identifier Attribute/Claim: From the drop-down list, select Name ID.
- x. Identifier Type: Click Email.

The SAML configuration is saved.
