

Configuring Peakon

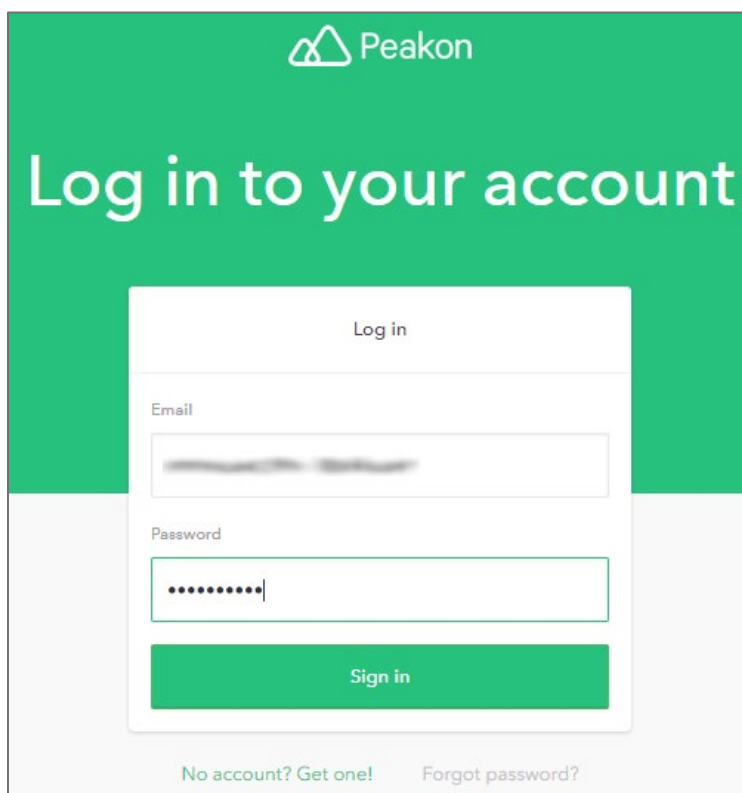
Configuring Peakon for single sign-on (SSO) enables administrators to manage users of Citrix ADC. Users can securely log on to Peakon by using the enterprise credentials.

Prerequisite

Browser Requirements: Internet Explorer 11 and above

To configure Peakon for SSO by using SAML:

1. In a browser, type <https://peakon.com/> and press **Enter**.
2. Type your Peakon admin account credentials (**Email** and **Password**) and click **Sign in**.

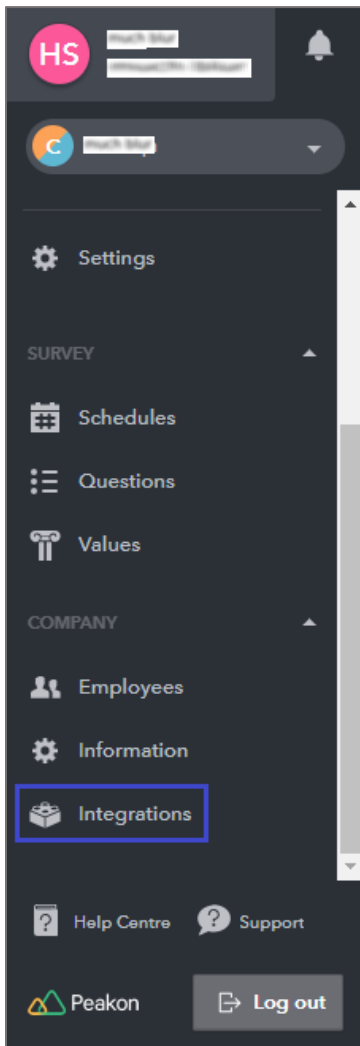

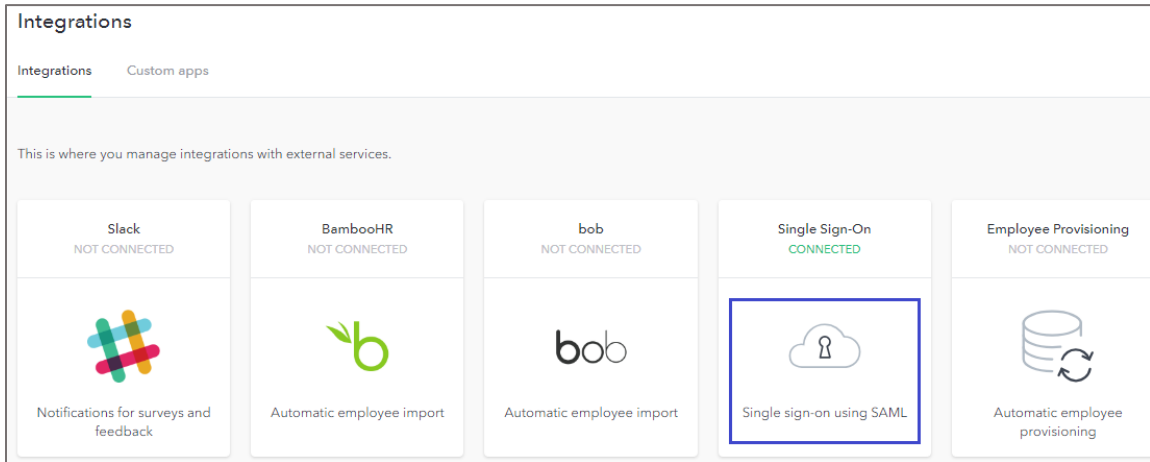

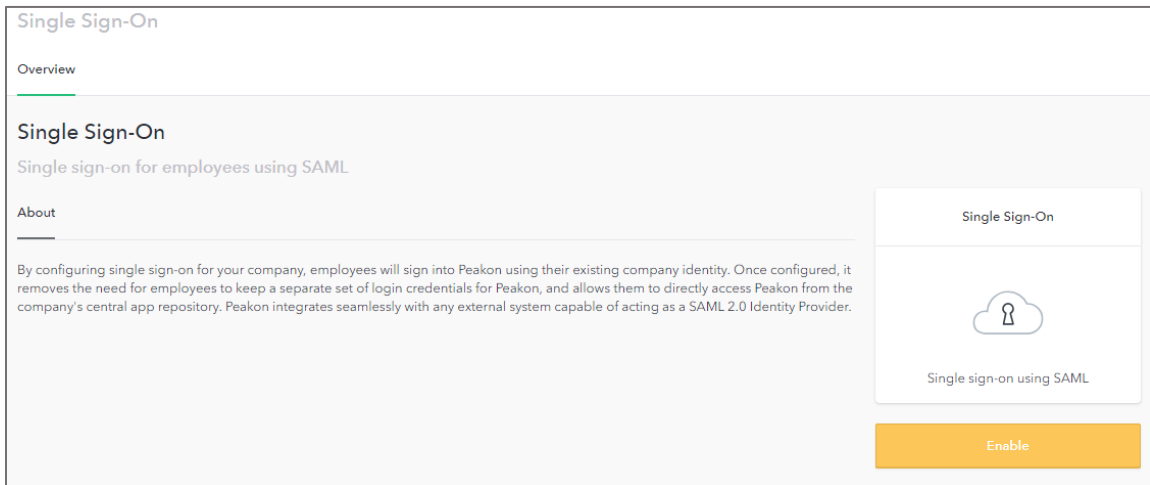
3. In the left panel, click **Integrations** under **COMPANY**.



4. In the **Integrations** page, click the **Single sign-on using SAML** tile.



5. To enable SSO using SAML, click **Enable**.



- In the **Settings** tab, enter the values for the following fields:

Field Name	Description
SSO Login URL	IdP logon URL
SSO Logout URL (Optional)	IdP logout URL
Certificate	Copy and paste the IdP certificate. The IdP Certificate is provided by Citrix and can be accessed from the link below: https://ssb4.mgmt.netscalergatewaydev.net/idp/saml/templatetest/idp_metadata.xml Note: Paste the certificate in Notepad and save the file in PEM format.

Note: Copy the **Entity ID** and **Reply URL (ACS)** for future reference.
