

Configuring Visual Paradigm

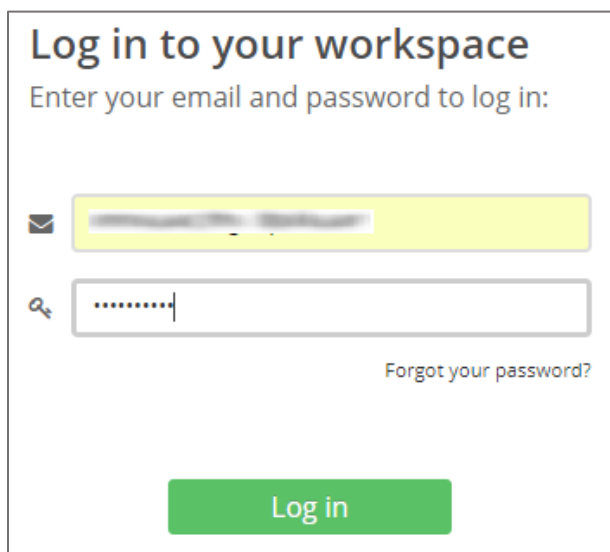
Configuring Visual Paradigm for single sign-on (SSO) enables administrators to manage users of Citrix ADC. Users can securely log on to Visual Paradigm by using the enterprise credentials.

Browser Requirements: Internet Explorer 11 and above

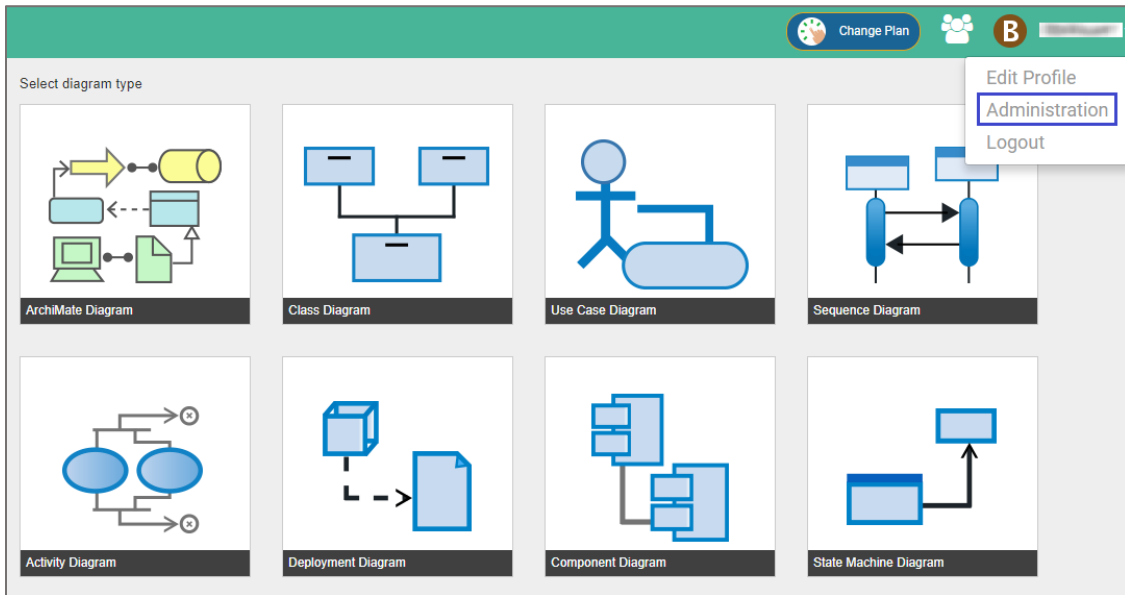
To configure Visual Paradigm for SSO by using SAML:

1. In a browser, type <https://online.visual-paradigm.com/login.jsp> and press **Enter**.
2. Type your Visual Paradigm admin account credentials (**Email** and **Password**) and click **Log in**.

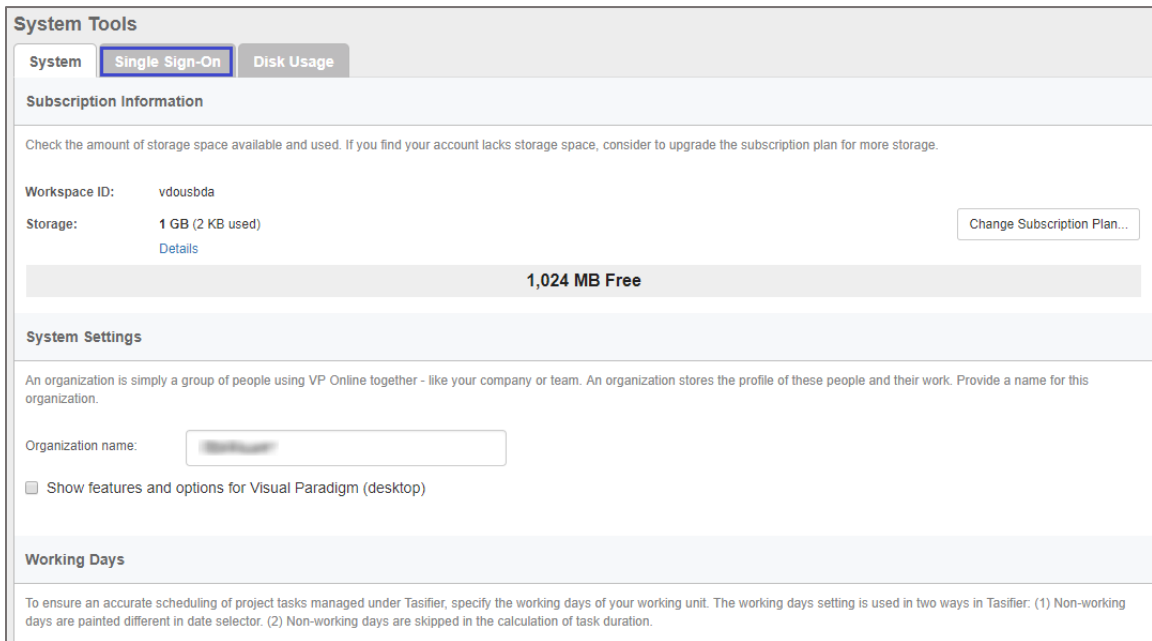
