

Configuring TextMagic


Configuring TextMagic for single sign-on (SSO) enables administrators to manage users of Citrix ADC. Users can securely log on to TextMagic by using the enterprise credentials.

Prerequisite

Browser Requirements: Internet Explorer 11 and above

To configure TextMagic for SSO by using SAML:

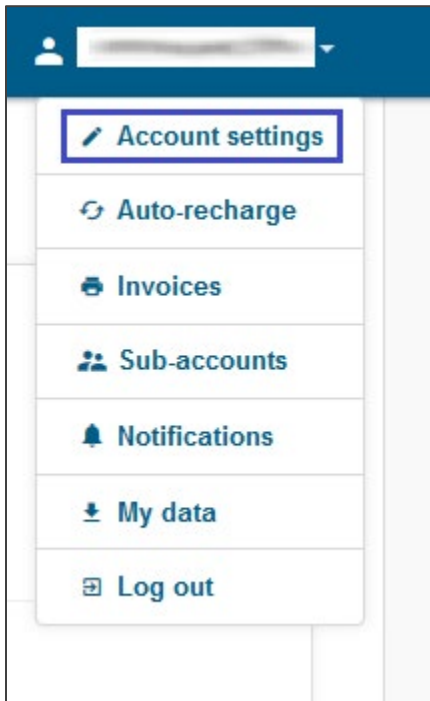
1. In a browser, type <https://www.textmagic.com/> and press **Enter**.
2. Type your TextMagic admin account credentials (**Username or Email** and **Password**) and click **Log in**.



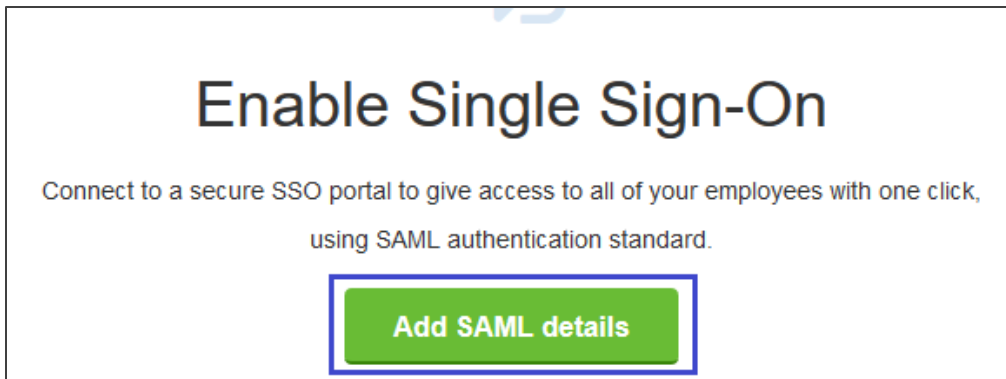
