Summary

This article lists the changes made to the XenServer 6.2.0 Software Development Kit (SDK).

Java, C, C# and PowerShell Bindings

Support for XenServer 4.0 has been removed.

C# Bindings

The public properties of the XenAPI classes have been made virtual. The purpose of this change is to aid developers of third-party applications to add unit test coverage to their code base.

PowerShell Bindings

This release includes two versions of the PowerShell language bindings:

1. The "old" PowerShell SDK
This is the previously released XenServer PowerShell v1.0 Snap-In and contains a number of bug fixes as well as the following changes:
 1. Installation requires the .NET Framework 3.5.
 2. The cmdlet `About-XenServer` has been removed. Instead use `Get-Help about_Xenserver`.The old PowerShell SDK is provided in this release for backwards compatibility, but will receive no further development effort after XenServer 6.2.0. As of XenServer 6.2.0 the old PowerShell SDK should be considered deprecated and users of the PowerShell SDK should transition to the new version for future compatibility.
2. The PowerShell SDK
This is a new, redesigned PowerShell v2.0 Snap-In, on which all further development will focus. Installation requires the .NET Framework 3.5.
