

# Configure Wrike for Single Sign-On

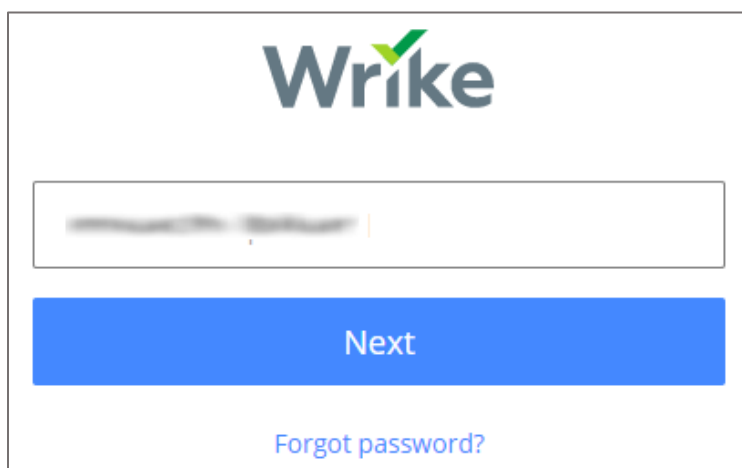
Configuring Wrike for single sign-on (SSO) enables administrators to manage users of Citrix ADC. Users can securely log on to Wrike by using the enterprise credentials.

## Prerequisite

Browser Requirements: Internet Explorer 11 and above

## To configure Wrike for SSO by using SAML:

1. In a browser, type <https://www.wrike.com/login/> and press **Enter**.
2. Type your Wrike email address and click **Next**.
