

# Configure Ziflow for Single Sign-On

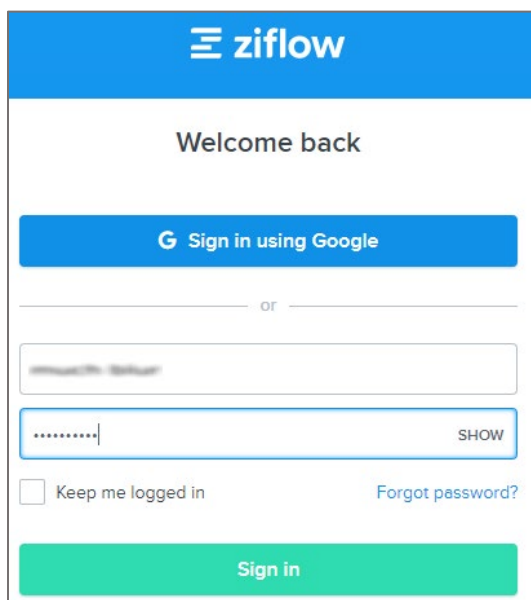
Configuring Ziflow for single sign-on (SSO) enables administrators to manage users of Citrix ADC. Users can securely log on to Ziflow by using the enterprise credentials.

## Prerequisite

Browser Requirements: Internet Explorer 11 and above

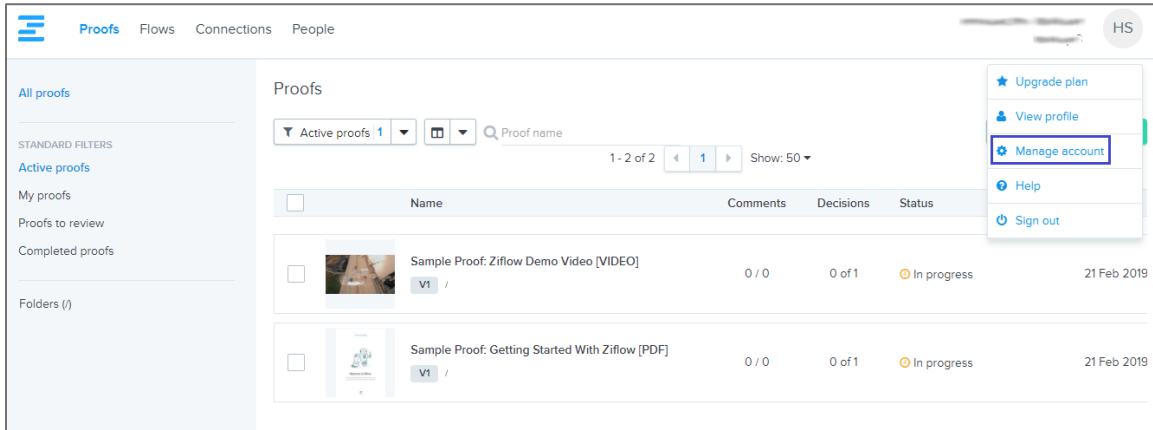
## To configure Ziflow for SSO by using SAML:

1. In a browser, type <https://www.ziflow.io/#/login/> and press **Enter**.
2. Type your Ziflow admin account credentials (**E-mail address** and **Password**) and click **Sign in**.

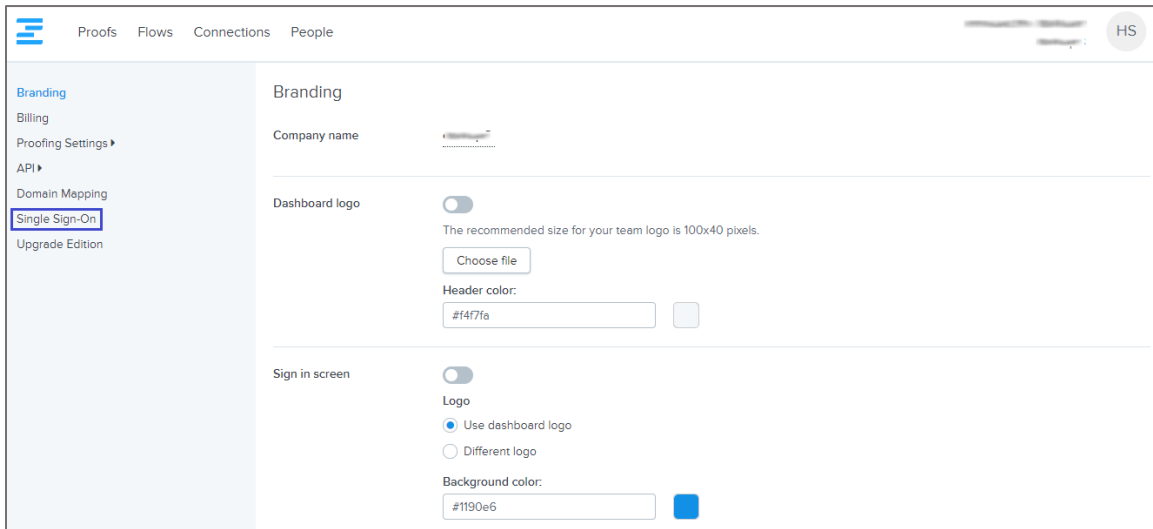
